

Are you prepared to love, bless, do good to, pray for and forgive your brother or sister?

That is the question.

An **offence** enters **our hearts** very easily and **forgiveness** is the cure. The Lord wants to **bless you**, but He can not **bless you** if you have an **unforgiving heart**.

Seeing that we all know what is written in [Matthew 6:14-15](#), [Mark 11:25-26](#) & [Luke 17:3-4](#), I will not write those Bible texts, but instead I will write about **the heart** of those messages: **an unforgiving heart**

An **unforgiving heart** is:

1. A **heart that will not let it go**
2. A **heart that won't drop the issue**
3. A **heart that will not give up resentment**
4. A **heart that refuses to forgive** the other
5. A **heart that holds on to and wallows** in the offence
6. A **heart that won't permit or allow or yield** forgiveness
7. A **heart that wants to punish or penalize or reprimand** the offender
8. A **heart nurturing your hurt and anger** with the result that **it interferes** with **your relationship with God**.

The Lord wants to **bless you** and **bless you abundantly** ([John 10:10](#)), but your **unforgiving heart is interfering** with **your relationship with God**.

A big part of **your relationship with God** is written about in: [Genesis 26:5](#), [Exodus 15:26](#), [Leviticus 26:2-3](#), [Numbers 15:40](#) & [Deuteronomy 30:16](#), but because you know that already, we will go directly to **the heart of your relationship with God**.

One word that comes back in all 5 Bible verses is: **Commandment; His commandments**.

Do you know that one of the meanings of commandment (in those 5 verses) means: **code of Wisdom**

So the **heart of your relationship with God** is tied up in a **code of Wisdom**.

The **heart of your relationship with God** is not burdensome ([Matthew 11:28-30](#))

The **heart of your relationship with God** is not bondage ([Romans 8:15](#))

The **heart of your relationship with God** is not brutal ([2 Timothy 3:2-7](#))

The heart of your relationship with God are blessings ([Psalms 133](#))
