If you **want to be blessed**, you will have to **change**. (Matthew 5:3-11)

Abram's name [exalted father] was **changed** and he **became** Abraham [father of a multitude].
Jacob's name [supplanter] was **changed** and he was **named** Israel [contender with God].
Moses status was **changed** from **prince of Egypt** to **deliverer of the Israelites**.
Even pharaoh **changed his mind** and **let the Israelites go**.

Change means to Adapt, to Adjust or to Amend. (1 Pet. 3:5; Rom. 12:16; Luke 13:5)
Change means to Renew, to Refine or to Replace. (Isa. 40:31; Mal. 3:3; Joel 2:25)
Change means to Substitute, to Soften or to Strengthen. (Mark 7:8; Luke 1:17; Isa. 41:10)
Change means to Transform, to Turn, or to Tender. (Rom. 12:2; Luke 1:16; Eph. 4:32)
Change means to Purge, to Prostrate or to Progress (1 Cor. 5:7; Dan. 2:46; Jude 1:20)

I have written above 15 meanings of **Change**, while there are more than 3000 times, in the Bible, written about **to make or become different**.

Change means **to make a difference** in your relationships.
Change means **to become different** in your relationships.
