

Do you want, desire **holiness** or **unholiness** to change your heart?

That is the question.

Holiness and **unholiness** has to do with **your heart desires**.

The desires of your heart are what people will see in your **words, attitude, decisions, speech, body language, actions** etc.

The desires of your heart will also influence your **thoughts, feelings, discerning, attention, reasoning, seeing** etc.

The desires of your heart may be **strong, steady** and **stable**, but that is what makes **your heart** also **inflexible**.

Someone who is **inflexible** is not open to the **Change** of the **Lord God**. Most people prefer to have a **secure, solid** and **safe** world, without any **Change** to their **comfort zone**. When you want to stay in your **secure, stable, steady, solid, safe** and **strong comfort zone**, you may miss out on something great, because **Change** means leaving your **comfort zone**.

The Israelites were in their **comfort zone**;

God provided a cloud over them to protect them from the desert sun.

God provided a pillar of fire to warm them at night.

God provided manna for the feeding of their bodies.

God provided water from a rock, so that they might drink.

Then God said, it is time to **Change**. The Israelites had **to fight** and **take** the **Promised Land** in by **Faith**. They had to leave their **comfort zone**, thus they had to **Change**. What happened was that they rebelled and had little **Faith**, so they were 40 years in the desert, because they did not want to leave their **comfort zone** and **Change**. When you are in your **comfort zone** you can become **inflexible**.

Flexibility means openness and willingness to **Change**, while **inflexibility** means closeness and unwillingness to **Change**.

God knows all **the desires of your heart**, but in order for **God** to give you **your hearts desires** you will have to **Change**.

Jesus Christ came to **Change** the closed door to an opened door, for us to have a **relationship** with **the Lord God**.

The Holy Spirit will come and live in **your heart** next to your **desires**, just give **Him** a chance to **Change your heart**.
